Rules & Guidelines

Contents & Specification:

- All Paper should be the Original one and it should not be published in any manner before and after the IYF 2018.
- All Authors and Co-authors must inform their respective Dept. Head/Principal/Guide about the paper submission of papers to IYF 2018.
- All Authors and Co-authors should write the correct affiliation inside the paper.
- Researchers and contributors, such as supervisors or tutors who assisted the project, must be acknowledged within the paper and presentation.
- The main author is a student/researcher who has written the presentation/paper independently even though other researchers or contributors may have been involved in the project or subject matter.
- A presentation/paper should present, as completely as possible, the original work of the author in planning the methodology, intervention, collecting data, data analysis, interpreting the results, and preparing the presentation/paper.
- The subject of a presentation/paper must be related to Yoga research, which is defined as the application of Yoga for the promotion of health and wellness.
- A presentation/paper based on course work, including thesis and dissertations are also eligible.
- An abstract of the presentation/paper is required before registration.
- The presentation/paper must be presented in the English.
- When written papers are required, they must be submitted in a typed form in English. The paper must consist of a minimum of 1,000 words of text, plus as many diagrams and supporting illustrations as necessary to clarify the subject matter.
- The paper must not exceed 3,000 words equivalent of text and diagrams, with each diagram considered to be the equivalent of 250 words.

To be noted:

1. *Submitting or presenting others work as your own will disqualify from the contest.*
2. *All research papers submitted for competition are checked with plagiarism detection software to verify its originality and find similarity percent of research paper.*
3. *If plagiarism is detected in research paper it will not be considered further for competition.*
4. *The presentation may not exceed 12 minutes (10+2); less presentation time may be allotted, to a minimum of 8 minutes for the presentation, depending on the number of contestants.*
5. *The time allowed for questions will be at the discretion of the moderator, questions will only be invited from the judging panel, not from the audience.*
6. *The Organizing Committee may not accept the papers submitted after the last date of registration.*

***The decision of the judges shall be final.**

The registration for the Research Paper would be done at registration counter on 22nd March, 2018 at the Yoga Fest Venue, Talkatora Indoor Stadium.
